



PRIMERA TEST 2017

Preliminary Level – YOUNG HORSE TEST

The test is to be performed in an arena of 60m x 20m.

For horses of 4-6 years old. The rider is allowed to enter the arena before the bell.

Snaffle bridle, spurs optional, whips are allowed. Time allowed 6 minutes.

Test may be performed in rising trot. Allotted time between tests: 8 minutes

Fig		Movements	Remarks
1	A S	Enter in medium walk, immediately track left and proceed to S on the right rein Halt, immobility, salute and proceed in medium walk.	
2	Between S and H	Working trot	
3	Between C and A	Serpentine 3 loops	
4	Over A	Before A walk and then back into working trot immediately after A	
5	KXM	Change the rein showing lengthening of strides	
6	C	Before C walk and then back into working trot immediately after C	
7	S	Medium walk	
8	Between E & B	Half 20m circle to the left in free walk on a long rein	
9	R	Working trot	
10	Between M & C	Working canter left	
11	S	Circle left 15 metres	

12	Between E & F	Change the rein, transition to trot when crossing the centre line.	
13	Between F & A	Working canter right	
14	V	Circle right 15 metres	
15	Between E & M	Change the rein, transition to trot when crossing the centre line.	
16	Between M & C	Working canter left	
17	Between HK	Medium canter strides	
18	F FXH	Working trot Change the rein, starting in working trot and transition to working canter right.	
19	RS	Half 20 metre circle right, give and retake the reins for 2-3 strides when crossing the centre line.	
20	Before C	Transition to working trot	
21	MXK	Change the rein showing lengthening of strides	
22	A	Down the centre line	
23	Between L & I	Transition to walk and then halt, immobility and salute	

Leave the arena at A in a free walk on a long rein
